

SARAH KREPP

Sarah Krepp has been a respected member of the Chicago art community for three decades, and as a teacher, curator and artist, she has made significant contributions to the city's cultural legacy. Krepp's multi-layered artworks and titles often incorporate scientific, media, or data-related themes that reflect the technology-driven society in which they were created. Maps, text, diagrams, charts, and other images and documents overlap to create a flurry of visual activity that obscure or reveal an underlying message.

Sarah Krepp received her Bachelor of Science and Art from Skidmore College, Saratoga Springs, NY and her MFA in painting from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. In 2012, Krepp exhibited her works at numerous locations throughout Chicago including BLOW-OUT at the Chicago Cultural Center, The Walking Drawings at Roy Boyd Gallery, as well as at the international exposition Art Chicago. Sarah previously served as Visiting Artist at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago and Professor and Chair for the Painting Program at the School of Art and Design at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. Currently, Krepp is the Director for DIALOGUE CHICAGO in Evanston, IL.

FIRAT ERDIM

Firat Erdim's work combines his interest in architectural and sculptural elements that have been influenced by ancient and post-industrial landscapes. Through this minimalist approach, Erdim presents views on how objects transform between states of nature, raw material, construction and ruin. In his reconstructed Post Series, his use of raw materials allows the viewer to see the past and future states of the structure, while commenting on the connection between its arrangement and deterioration.

Erdim received his Bachelor of Architecture from The Cooper Union, New York, NY and his Master of Architecture from the University of Virginia, Charlottesville, VA. He previously served as a Teaching Artist at Marwen Foundation, Chicago, IL and Adjunct Assistant Professor at the College of Architecture at Illinois Institute of Technology, Chicago, IL. Erdim currently lives and teaches in Turkey at Izmir University of Economics.
