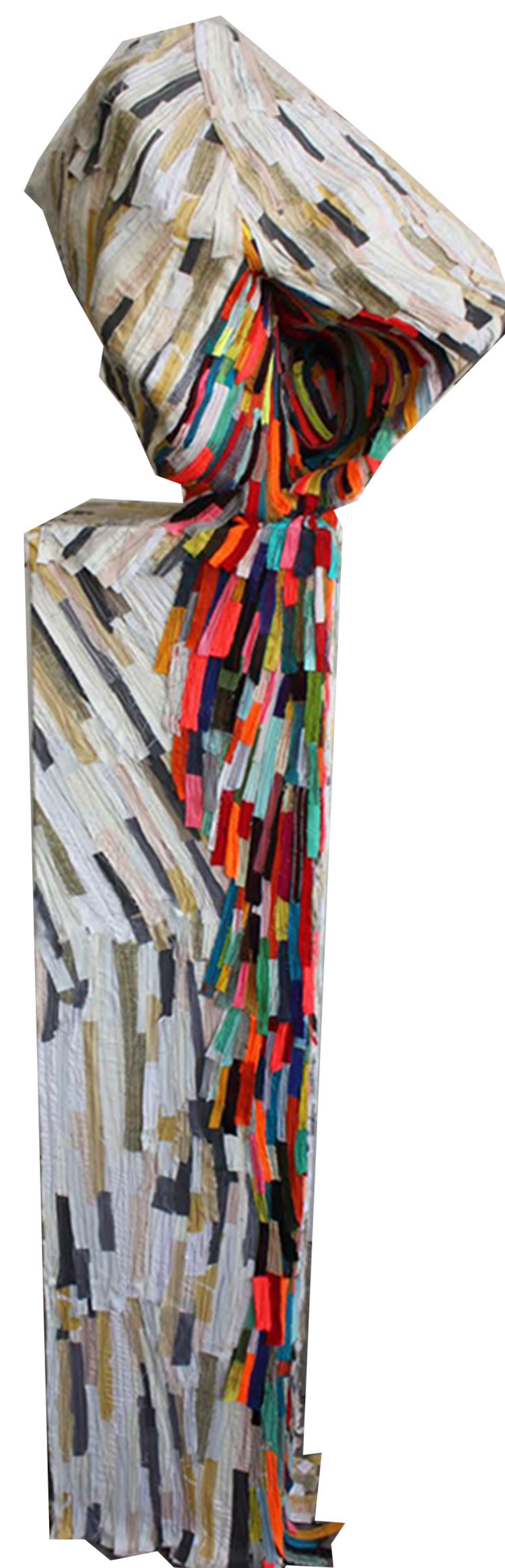
### ANDREA MYERS

Andrea Myers is a Chicago-based artist, who received her BFA in Printmedia and her MFA in Fiber and Material studies, from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Previous to that, she attended a program in printmaking and book arts through the University of Georgia in Cortona, Italy. Myers has held residencies at Tulane University, LA; Ox-Bow School of Art, MI; Central Michigan University, MI and the Contemporary Artist's Center, MA.

Myers considers herself an artist who constructs painterly sculptures, combining elements from painting, printmaking, and sculpture. She creates installations that explore the relationship between two and three dimensional media - construction and deconstruction. A beautiful decay of color and texture result from Myers' process of reduction and buildup with layers of paper and fiber.

She has earned several scholarships and awards from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, as well as an MFA Fellowship. Chicago institutions such as the Union League Club, the Community Arts Assistance Program, and the Beverly Arts Center have recognized Myers' body of work. She has participated in group and solo exhibitions around the country, as well as been commissioned for several site specific outdoor sculptures and lobbies. Andrea was an instructor at Columbia College, and currently serves as the Adjunct Instructor for Foundations/Fine Art programs at Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, OH.
