NEIL GOODMAN


Chicago sculptor, Neil Goodman has long been influenced by the sculptural qualities of the industrial and urban landscape found throughout the Midwest. Goodman draws upon objects such as mills, metal bridges and cranes for inspiration.

Though one of the main influences on Goodman's sculpture is machinery, he is also interested in nature and the mathematical proportions of Moorish architecture, which have also made their way into his work.

Goodman's linear and organic forms are an experimentation of size as well as repeating shapes. Visitors are encouraged to walk among his sculptures to fully experience the size relationships, different viewpoints, textures and recurring configurations.

Goodman is a Professor of Fine Arts at Indiana University Northwest and has created sculpture for the university; art museums as well as other institutions including UBS and AT&T Corporate Center, both in Chicago.

VERA KLEMENT

Vera Klement, a distinguished Chicago-based artist, conveys expressive and contemplative works bathed in the lavish surface of paint and sumptuous renderings of figurative elements on large canvases.

For Vera, paintings must meet three requirements: "they are objects that must be universally recognizable, belong to no specific time period, and, through the conduit of metaphor be capable of yielding up a multiplicity of meaning."

The creation dates for paintings featured in this installation span over two decades. These works provide an overall sense of the language of Vera's paintings, her passion for surface and insight into her struggle to explore the mystery of life.

Her work is included in many major collections including the Art Institute of Chicago, the Museum of Contemporary Art in Chicago, the Museum of Modern Art, The Corcoran, The Tate, and the Walker Art Center.
